The Memorial Forest is meant to be a natural forest, one you can visit and enjoy and know that one of the trees has been planted in memory of your loved one. **To ensure the Burnsmead area remains a natural forest there will be no choosing of trees and no markers or mementos are to be left by the trees. Anything left in the forest will be removed at the request of the Province of Alberta.**

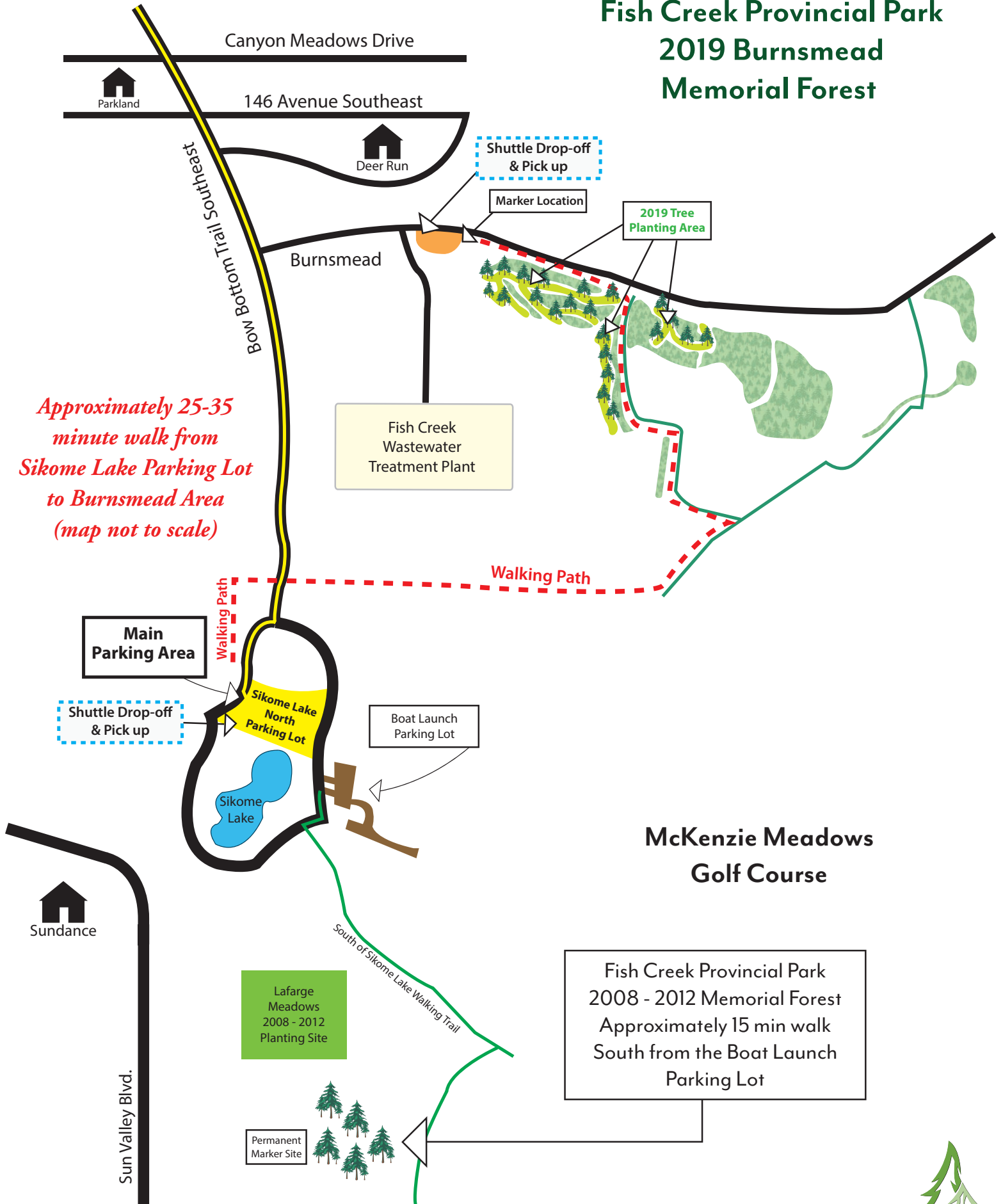
Parking

The Burnsmead Forest is in a quiet, secluded area of Fish Creek Park, North of Sikome Lake. Due to the parking limitations in the Burnsmead area, we will have parking available in the Sikome North parking lots. McInnis & Holloway will provide shuttle services to and from the parking areas and this year's planting area. If you prefer to walk, there will be a clearly marked pathway available. This is an approximate 25-35 minute walk. Dogs on a leash are welcome in the park and on the shuttle services.
